The abstract should succinctly describe the results reported, as this is the only written record prepared for this meeting. You may, however, distribute any preprints or reprints you wish to other participants at the time of the meeting; in the past, many participants found this to be a valuable way to disseminate their research results.

Authors must prepare their abstract for direct reproduction in the abstract book; the abstract text will appear precisely as the author prepared it. Abstracts (**one page limit**) should be single-spaced with type no smaller than 10 point. A couple of figures can be inserted in the abstract, but gray scale images may not reproduce well. The content of the abstract should fit into a 15-cm-wide by 24-cm-high rectangle, and be formatted as follows. The title of the abstract should be in a type size 2 points larger than the authorstext material, bold type, upper and lower case, and centered on a line by itself. Leave one blank line under the title and on the next line, type the authors' names, centered, <u>underlining the presenting author</u>. Centered on the next line(s), type the affiliation(s) and address(s); superscripts may be used to designate different addresses and affiliations of authors. Leave one blank line and then begin the body of the abstract on the next line. Any references or support acknowledgments must be included within the text of the abstract.
