## **About this Seminar**

This presentation discusses the practice of consensus decision-making by the Antarctic Treaty Consultative Parties (ATCPs) to protect the Antarctic environment, taking the regulation of Antarctic tourism as a case study. While highlighting the importance of the consensus rule, the current practice poses a challenge to ensuring timely and adequate international responses to environmental concerns. Options for strengthening Antarctic decision-making will be considered.
