Ekaterina is currently a postdoctoral fellow at the University of Hamburg, Germany, researching on public international law and the law of the sea. She is originally from Russia, and holds a JD with distinction from Mari State University, Russia; and an LL.M. in International and Comparative Law from The Ohio State University, USA. Ekaterina received her Ph.D. at Queen's University, Canada, Her Ph.D. research was devoted to the delimitation of the extended continental shelves in the Central Arctic Ocean.

In this presentation, taking into account the most recent Russian submission to CLCS, Ekaterina will discuss likely scenarios for the future delimitation of the extended continental shelves in the Central Arctic Ocean between Canada, Denmark, and Russia.
