

Invitation for Collaborative Research on Arctic/Antarctic Legal & Policy Issues with JSPS Fellowship—Academic Year 2021

Interest must be indicated to the PCRC as soon as possible.

For the second recruitment of Postdoctoral SHORT-TERM [PE] fellowship

Draft application must be received by PCRC no later than 4 December 2020.

As prestigious fellows of the Japan Society for the Promotion of Science (JSPS), the Polar Cooperation Research Centre (PCRC) at Kobe University is offering to host a few scholars who are interested in collaborative research on Arctic and/or Antarctic legal and policy issues starting in the second half of 2021 academic year (arrival date between August/September 2021 and March 2022). The Centre particularly welcomes fellows whose stay in Kobe coincide with 14th Polar Law Symposium to be held in November 2021 in Kobe, Japan.

Please be reminded that the successful fellows will need to abide by all Japanese and local regulations relating to COVID-19 when entering Japan. The fellowship is conditional on the physical presence of the fellow in Japan.

There are two broad categories in the JSPS fellowship program: (1) Postdoctoral Fellowships and (2) Invitation Fellowships (please also see the table below).

- (1) The Postdoctoral Fellowship [P] or [PE] is a competitive fellowship for doctoral students and postdoctoral researchers with funding for round-trip airfare to Kobe, up to ¥362,000JPY stipend per month (equivalent to \$3,400USD €2,900EUR), and other allowances. The duration of the research is 12-24 months for the STANDARD [P] type of fellowship (applicants must have already received Ph.D. at the time of arrival in Japan) and 1-12 months for the SHORT-TERM [PE] fellowship (applicants who are expecting to receive Ph.D. are also eligible. The short-term fellowship is available only for nationals/citizens of US, Canada, EU countries, Switzerland, Norway and Russia). There are multiple application opportunities depending on the timing of arrival in Japan.
- (2) The Invitation Fellowship SHORT-TERM [S] is also a competitive fellowship for overseas researchers in a position equivalent to a university professor. The duration of the SHORT-TERM [S] fellowship is 14-60 days and it provides round-trip flights costs and ¥18,000JPY (equivalent to \$170USD, €140EUR) per day. This year, we are offering



only the second recruitment application, the deadline for which is in mid April 2021.

Please read carefully the <u>JSPS</u> application guidelines and check your eligibility. Please note that the JSPS fellowship application process requires a close communication with the receiving professor well before the deadlines, involving several documents coproduced by the applicant and the receiving professor. The <u>PCRC</u> is looking for those applicants who have concrete plans to come to Kobe to do specific collaborative research.

Those interested in applying for the JSPS fellowship for the 2021 academic year, in any category [P][PE][S], must contact the PCRC <kobe_arctic_research@diamond.kobe-u.ac.jp> as soon as possible, with following information:

- (i) The type of the fellowship and the round of recruitment for which you would like to apply (after carefully checking your eligibility);
- (ii) The expected arrival and departure dates of your preferred stay in Kobe;
- (iii) Your CV, including your nationality/citizenship, birthdate, the date or expected date of your doctoral degree; and
- (iv) Your research topic, with the explanation how that topic contributes to the research undertaken at PCRC and/or by Professor Shibata.

For the second recruitment of Postdoctoral SHORT-TERM [PE] fellowship, after close consultation with the PCRC, the draft application must be submitted no later than 4 December 2020.
