

## Invitation for Collaborative Research on Arctic/Antarctic Legal & Policy Issues with JSPS Fellowship—Academic Year 2019

## Interest must be indicated to the PCRC no later than 17 July 2018.

As distinguished fellows of the Japan Society for the Promotion of Science (JSPS), the Polar Cooperation Research Centre (PCRC) at Kobe University is offering to host a few scholars who are interested in collaborative research on Arctic and/or Antarctic legal and policy issues starting in the 2019 academic year (starting date between April 2019 and March 2020). The Centre particularly welcomes fellows whose stay in Kobe coincide with 2019 symposium in December and/or 2020 symposium in August.

There are two broad categories in the JSPS fellowship program: (1) Postdoctoral Fellowships and (2) Invitation Fellowships (please also see the table below).

- (1) The Postdoctoral Fellowship is a competitive fellowship for doctoral students and postdoctoral researchers with funding for round-trip airfare to Kobe, up to ¥362,000JPY stipend per month (equivalent to \$3,300USD €2,700EUR), and other allowances. The duration of the research is 12-24 months for the STANDARD type of fellowship (applicants must have already received Ph.D. at the time of arrival in Japan) and 1-12 months for the SHORT-TERM fellowship (applicants who are expecting to receive Ph.D. are also eligible. The short-term fellowship is available only for nationals/citizens of US, Canada, EU countries, Switzerland, Norway and Russia). There are multiple application opportunities depending on the timing of arrival in Japan. Please also note that Icelandic citizens may apply for the SHORT-TERM fellowship only if they have earned a master's or higher degree and continuously thereafter have been engaged in research for a period of at least three years at a university or research institution in an eligible country (US, Canada, EU countries, Switzerland, Norway or Russia) before the time their applications are submitted.
- (2) The Invitation Fellowship is also a competitive fellowship for overseas researchers in a position equivalent to a university professor or associate professor. There are LONG-TERM fellowships for mid-career researchers and SHORT-TERM fellowships for established researchers. The duration of the long-term fellowship is 2-10 months and it provides round-trip flights costs and \(\frac{1}{2}\)387,600JPY (equivalent to



\$3,500USD €2,900EUR) per month. The duration of the short term fellowship is 14-60 days and it provides round-trip flights costs and ¥18,000JPY (equivalent to \$164USD, €137EUR) per day. There is only one application opportunity per year for the LONG-TERM fellowship in August, whereas there are two application opportunities per year for SHORT-TERM fellowship in August 2018 and March 2019 (depending on the timing of arrival in Japan).

Those interested in applying for the JSPS fellowship for the 2019 academic year, after carefully reading the <u>JSPS application guidelines</u> and checking your eligibility, must contact the PCRC <kobe\_arctic\_research@diamond.kobe-u.ac.jp> **no later than** 17 July 2018<sup>1</sup>, with following information:

- (i) The type of the fellowship and the round of recruitment for which you would like to apply;
- (ii) The period for which you would like to stay in Kobe;
- (iii) Your CV; and
- (iv) Your research topic, with the explanation how that topic contributes to the research pursued under PCRC and/or by Professor Shibata.

Please note that the JSPS fellowship application process requires a close communication with the receiving professor well before the deadlines, involving several documents co-produced by the applicant and the receiving professor. The PCRC is looking for those applicants who have concrete plans to come to Kobe to do specific collaborative research.
